At the push of a button – the roof elevates SILENTLY – almost doubling the interior space – giving headroom for a giant, but operational by the smallest member of the family.






Having elevated the "Autoroof" you reveal the fully upholstered double bed 6ft long.

Now you're all set for dining.


The table locates on a central leg between the front and rear settee – and still leaves ample room for someone to stand by the kitchen equipment, which is housed in attractive pine with Hessian door insets and hard-wearing Warerite laminated top surfaces.

All cupboard doors are crank hinged so that they fold back flush against the units – for safety and space.





To convert the rear settee into a 6ft 5in double bed is the easiest operation – just remove the backrest bar, lift the base of the rear settee and pull – the backrest drops down – and the King Size bed by any standard – 6ft 5in \times 4ft 5in wide at the head tapering at the base – allows easy access to the kitchen equipment.


The cooker is a stainless steel two-burner and grill Camping Gaz appliance, housed in aluminium for easy cleaning and heat resistance.






Situated next to the cooker is a beautifully finished stainless steel sink and draining board – large enough for all your requirements, and the 6 gallons of water (contained in 3×2 gallon water porters for easy cleaning and maintenance) are fed to the sink by a retractable foot pump.

This superb, top-loading Italian refrigerator has an incredible capacity of 35 litres – and runs off Camping Gaz, mains 240 volt electricity or 12 volt, and is deep enough to hold and chill bottles of Hock. All items shown – really are average contents.






Fitted to the exterior of the vehicle, there is a flush-mounted mains inlet socket – from which you can operate your refrigerator direct or, by feeding it through the charge and distribution unit, you can recharge your car battery in a matter of hours.
